Judging Demystified

Every month we publish photos of orchids that have won AOS (American Orchid Society) awards issued by our local AOS judging center, which is right here in Hilo. But have you ever wondered how the AOS judges decide which plants get awards? And who are these AOS judges, anyway, and how do you become a judge?

This month, our own Karen Kimmerle will tell all about AOS judging, including an interactive faux judging session so you can see exactly what goes on.



Karen is an accredited AOS judge and is currently

the chair of the AOS judging center at Hilo and of the Hawaii state judging region. She was born and raised in Portland, Oregon but came to Hilo in 1975. A year later she happened on an orchid show in Hilo, which kindled her interest in growing orchids. Forty years later, she and her husband run a large backyard orchid nursery, Island Sun Orchids, in Kapoho. Her love of orchids has led her on many trips around the U.S. and internationally. She says, "I have been so fortunate to have a passion that has taught me many skills in life and allowed me to travel and meet many interesting people. And I still get excited about orchids!"
